

The Gap



Women in finance earn, on average, 71 cents to every dollar earned by men.





Women make up 15.4% of executive officers in the finance industry and hold only 22% of board seats in finance companies on the S&P 500.

Women in finance are 20% more likely than men to receive critical feedback in their performance reviews.
